

Leucoagaricus Locq. ex Singer, *Sydowia* **2**(1-6): 35 (1948).

Lectotype *Leucoagaricus rubrotinctus* (Peck) Singer 1948, hic designatus.

Although Singer (1948) validated and elevated Locquin's invalid subgeneric name '*Leucocoprinus* sect. *Leucoagaricus*' and named as 'species typica' '*L. macrorhizus* (Locquin.) Singer' that name was invalid, lacking Latin. Two other valid names were available, *L. excoriatus* and *L. rubrotinctus*. The latter is chosen because it is still currently recognized as a *Leucoagaricus* phylogenetically. By this lectotypification, the name '*Leucoagaricus* sect. *rubrotincta*' coined by Singer (1948) and typified by *L. rubrotinctus*, becomes the autonym *Leucoagaricus* sect. *Leucoagaricus*. The name *Leucoagaricus macrorhizus* Locq. ex E. Horak was later validated in 1968.
