

Mushrooms nomenclatural novelties no. 2

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Brunneoporus Audet, gen.nov.

It differs from *Antrodia* s. str. by basidiomata deeper brownish, by distinctly brownish interwoven skeletal hyphae, by often short basidia, very rarely pedunculate, mostly about 20-25 µm long, by uninucleated not regularly fusiform distal end basidiospores.

Holotype : *Trametes malicola* Berk. & M.A. Curtis 1856.

Comment: The new genus is supported by the molecular analyses in Ortiz-Santana et al. 2013 (Mycologia 105 (6): 1391-1411), Han et al. 2016 (Fungal Diversity 80 :343-373) and Spirin et al. 2016 (Mycological Progress 15 (5): 1-12).

Etymology: from the Latin word brunneus = brownish and porus = pore.
