

Nomenclatural novelties : Alexander B. Doweld

Mononemataceae Doweld, fam.nov.

Unbranched filaments elongate, consisting of swollen pairs of cells, each pair connected to the others by a narrow zone or separated from them by an isthmus; basal cell slightly tapered, attached to the cuticle by the narrower end. Pairs of cells arised by intercalary division, uninucleate, never coenocytic, apparently disarticulate in the manner of arthrospores and function as propagules. Parasitic in foregut (stomodeum) of Chilopoda. TYPE: *Mononema* Balbiani 1889.

Mononematales Doweld, ord.nov.

Unbranched filaments consisting of swollen pairs of cells, arised by intercalary division, uninucleate, never coenocytic, apparently disarticulate in the manner of arthrospores and function as propagules. Parasitic in foregut (stomodeum) of Chilopoda. TYPE: *Mononema* Balbiani 1889.
